The Summer School of the School of Bologna in Ravenna will focus on important topics of the law of transnational contracts, as concerns both the substantial regulation and the main features of judicial litigation. Lecturers come from the University of Bologna and other foreign Universities and are well known experts of these areas of the law.

Lectures will mix academic perspectives with practical insights, in a comparative perspective, linking together the European, American and Chinese experiences.

Italian lawyers will be awarded 20 formative credits by the Ordine degli Avvocati of Ravenna for their participation in the Summer School.
